

It is 30 years since the Oka Crisis magnified tensions between French Canadian settlers and the Mohawk community in neighboring Kanesatake as a sometimes violent standoff boiled through the summer of 1990. Mohawk filmmaker Tracey Deer was 12 then and she has turned her memories into a singularly compelling and political coming-of-age movie about a young girl (Kiawentiio) engaged in her own personal rebellion. Sensitively drawn, alternately delicate and raw, Deer's movie is moving and important testimony.
