

Like his father, and his father before him, Jesmark fishes the Mediterranean from a hand-painted wooden boat, a "luzzu". But over-fishing is taking its toll, and so are counter-productive EU regulations. A father himself now, Jesmark is compelled to dabble in the black market. But this proves a slippery slope...

Adapting Nella Larson's 1920s novella, actor-turned-director Rebecca Hall has fashioned a crisp, piquant tale about two women friends (Tessa Thompson and Ruth Negga), one of whom is married to a white man who doesn't know her ethnicity. Actor-turned-director Elle-Maija Tailfeathers (The Body Remembers When the World Broke Open; Night Raiders) has made arguably the most important film about addiction to come out of this country; a patient, personal documentary that is equally about colonialism, racism, and compassion. Central to this story is Dr. Esther Tailfeathers, the filmmaker's mother, whose espousal of the Blackfoot virtue of kímmapiiyipitssini (empathy for all) embodies the only real answer to the anguish of the opioid epidemic.


