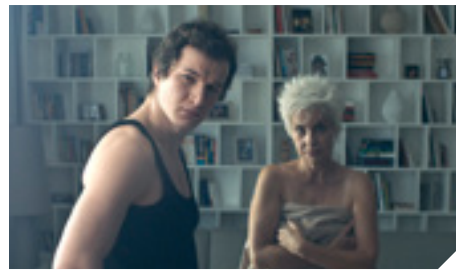

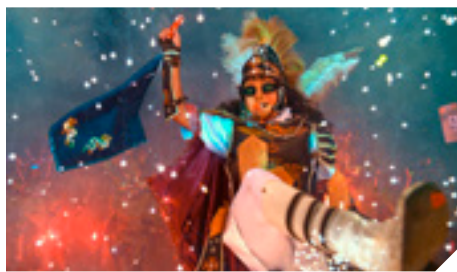

Over the years, Taiwanese filmmaker Tsai Ming-liang (*Goodbye Dragon Inn*; *Stray Dogs*) has given himself over to the contemplative rhythms of slow cinema. His latest—his first feature since 2013—consists of two dozen fixed frame compositions, each held for about 5 minutes. As you become attuned to this minimalist aesthetic—a kind of cinematic yoga exercise for the mind—the film's quotidian surfaces yield up deep reservoirs of emotion.

In the spring of 1941, wide-eyed 17-year-old Toshihiko arrives in Karatsu and befriends a group of teenage classmates who fall in love, quarrel and stumble through their remaining days of youth as war looms on the horizon.
